He was responsible for the development of India's first satellite launch vehicle, the SLV-3 and the development of strategic missiles. Kalam held various positions in the Indian Space Research Organization and the Defense Reserach and Development Organizaion. He became the principal scientific asdviser to the Govt. of India, holding the rank of a Cabinet Minister. The President of India between 2002 to 2007 Kalam was awarded honorary doctorates from thirty eight universities. He was also the receipient of the country's three highest civilian honours Padma Bhushan (1981), Padma Vibhushan (1990) and Bharat Ratna (1997).
